VOLLEYBALL BEACH FUTURES

Volleyball Beach Futures is the very first ‘Futures’ event for beach volleyball—bringing together talented junior athletes born between **2010 and 2012** from across the country. This national team-style camp is designed to support the development of young athletes who aspire to represent England in the future. The camp is open to all abilities.

Please note: You do not need a British passport or England as your Federation of Origin to take part—this camp is open to everyone.

At Volleyball Futures, athletes will experience a national team training environment, learning what it means to train like an England athlete. Athletes will work closely with National Team coaches, develop essential volleyball fundamentals, and gain insight into the standards and expectations of high-performance beach volleyball. The camp focuses on both how to train effectively and why mastering the basics is crucial for long-term success.

Programme Overview

A national team-style experience led by Head Coach **Sam Dunbavin**, with a focus on **Talent Identification** and **skill development** for junior beach athletes.

Additional Activity

The Kirk Pitman Beach Volleyball Director will be running a BVDC Coach Development Programme alongside the event to support coaching development.

At the camp the players will:

- have three volleyball training sessions, led by national team coach Sam Dunbavin
- get advice on what to do to improve

This camp is first come, first serve, the maximum capacity is 72.

HOW TO BOOK

***Please remember the camp is only open to athletes born between 2010 and 2012.**

Code of Conduct/Athlete Agreement

Please read the code of conduct on the next page carefully. It sets out Volleyball England's expectations of Volleyball Futures participants. The player and their parents/carers must agree to the terms and conditions when booking on to the event.

Parental Permission

Volleyball England is only responsible for athletes during the camp. Parents are responsible for their child's travel arrangements to and from Leyton (Sideout) BVDC. The athletes must be collected promptly at the end of the camp.

Medical Information and Consent

You will be asked information about your health and your parents will be asked to give consent for your to be treated if you get injured as part of the booking process.

Photography and Video Recording

Should parents wish to take photographs or record images at the Volleyball Futures you will need to complete the SP4 Form and bring it with you.

VOLLEYBALL FUTURES CODE OF CONDUCT

The Volleyball Futures is a valuable experience to help you develop as a player. Volleyball England expects the highest of standards of behaviour from our athletes. We expect all athletes attending to accept and adhere to these standards set out below.

- As an athlete at the Volleyball Futures, I will be representing my club, my family and myself. I take full responsibility for my actions.
- I will treat everyone with the respect and fairness that I would like them to show me.
- I will always demonstrate proper personal/professional behaviour, promoting a positive image of myself.
- I will respect others regardless of race, gender, disability, ethnicity, sexuality or religious beliefs and I will not tolerate or be involved in discrimination of any kind.
- I will keep my mobile phone switched off during sessions unless invited to use it as part of the session.
- I will ensure my use of social networking sites promote positive images and comments of the Volleyball Futures.
- I will not smoke and possess or consume alcohol or illegal drugs whilst at the Volleyball Futures.
- I will not leave the venue at any time during the camp.
- I agree that a full report of any misconduct will be forwarded to my parents/guardians if so required.
- I permit Volleyball England to take photographs and video for media purposes. Any media taken will be used suitably and with discretion.
- I agree that my personal information can be used by Volleyball England staff for the purpose of administration in line with the Volleyball England GDPR Data Protection policy and Privacy policy.

VENUE

Location

Leyton (Sideout) BVDC. (Ive Farm Sports Ground, London, UK E10 5UE).

TIMINGS

- Arrival / registration - 9am

- Departure - 5pm
- Full confirmation of timings will be sent with the information email on 3rd July 2025.

Ensure that you **create the Volleyzone account for the child** you want to book into Volleyball Futures. Otherwise, the booking will be rejected, and you will be refunded. This may lead to your child missing the opportunity.

Creating an account with VolleyZone is a two-step process: Creating an account and activating the account:

1. To create a VolleyZone member account: open the member registration portal by clicking [here](#). Choose the regional association and county that your club is part of > scroll down and you will see a list of clubs within the county > select the club you wish to register into > scroll down and choose the membership-type > click on 'Register Now'. This will take you to the registration-login page. On the registration-login page > click on 'Sign up' > fill in all the required details > accept the 'Terms and Conditions' > click on 'Register'.
2. To activate the account: you will have received an account activation email on the email address you provided in the last stage > click on 'Activate Account' which will bring you to the VolleyZone member login page > enter your email address and password > click on 'Log In'. REGISTERING AND PAYING FOR VOLLEYBALL FUTURES

1. Log into your [VolleyZone account](#)
2. On the drop-down menu in the top right corner, ensure you have Volleyball England selected and not your current club.
3. In the "Event" section click "Add"
4. In the "Search/filter options" "enter "Futures" in the Event Name option.
5. Select the event you want to book on.
6. Add it to your cart.
7. Follow the booking process.
8. Once completed you will receive a confirmation email from VolleyZone.
9. The event will appear in your child's VolleyZone Account.

If you do not receive the confirmation email this means you have not fully completed the booking process and your child cannot attend the event.

If this process is not working, try accessing the event using the [courses](#) button featured at the top of the Volleyball England website.

REFUNDS

If an athlete is not able to attend the Futures once they have registered the following applies:

- If it is more than ten working days before the start of the camp – full refund or transfer on to the next camp.
- If it is less than ten working days before the start of the camp – no refund

Exceptional Circumstances

Refunds may be considered in very exceptional circumstances and only if Volleyball England has not already paid for the goods or services. Each case will be considered individually.
